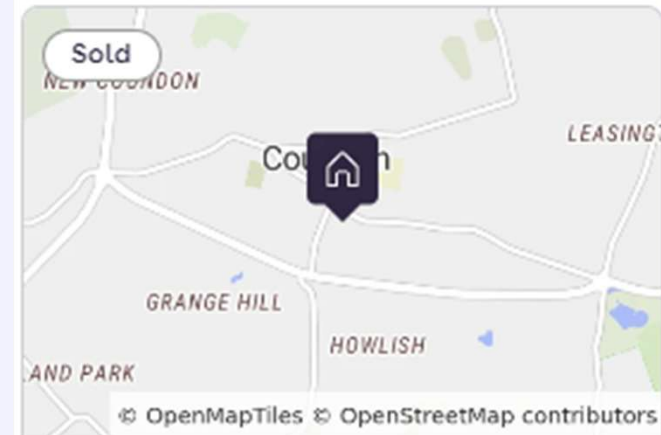
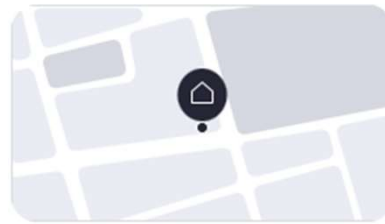

8 South View, Coundon is a **freehold terraced house** spread over **764 square feet** (71m²), making it one of the larger homes on South View. Built between 1930 and 1949, it is currently valued at **£74,000** — on price it's ranked 3rd out of 13 properties in the **DL14 8NB** postcode where the average price is currently £61,000.

Over the past year, prices across **DL14.8** have grown by 5.9% year-on-year whilst sales transactions fell slightly — the average terraced house price now stands at £70,000 (based on actual sales over the past year). Property in **DL14.8NB** is priced broadly in line with the wider DL14.8 area.

Sales activity in DL14 8NB has remained broadly stable over the last 3 years, with 4 transactions recorded — in line with the historic average for this postcode. DL14 8NB has a notable proportion of rental properties alongside owner-occupiers.

Why Coundon?

Coundon is a small town in County Durham, England located with a population of about 7,000 at last count. It has a number of useful shops, schools and pubs and is close to several railway stations such as the one in Bishop Auckland 1.9 miles away, Shildon 2.3 miles away, Newton Aycliffe 3.6 miles away and Durham 8.5 miles away.

Coundon is nextdoor to the popular Market town of Bishop Auckland which has a population of around 24k. It is located about 12 miles northwest of Darlington, 12 miles South Viewwest of Durham and 5 miles South Vieweast of Crook.

During the Industrial Revolution the town grew rapidly as coal mining took hold as an important industry. Today the largest sector of employment in the town is manufacturing. West Auckland has a new shopping centre with Tesco's and various other superstores which is a great attraction to the area. Much of Bishops Auckland's early history surrounds the establishment of a hunting lodge which became know as Auckland Castle and was the main residence of the Bishops of Durham who for centuries were virtual rulers of a vast swath of land in the north-east of England.

Nowadays as part of the towns rejuvenation, they have restored the spires and grand state rooms of Auckland Castle. The £12.4 million restoration of the castle is part of the [Auckland Project](#), an ambitious £150 million regeneration scheme that already includes the [Mining Art Gallery](#) and a viewing tower which are helping with the tourist boom in the area.
